Burnt offering	Ascension offering	1:1-17; 6:8-13	An animal	All is burned except skin, which priest receives	Yes	Removes sin in general	Recognizes sin is big; also shows we offer whole self to God
Grain offering	Gift offering	2:1-16; 6:14-18; 7:28-36	Grain and oil	Handful is burned up; priests get the rest for their food	No	Honors God as ruler, creator, giver	Reminds us that God is the source of life, meaning, and blessing
Peace offering	Fellowship offering	3:1-17; 7:11-21	Meat and bread	Fat is burned; priests get some food; the person eats the rest with others	No	Gives thanks to God; joy in eating together	Depicts life of the church
Sin offering	Purification offering	4:1-5:13; 6:24-30	A ram	Fat is burned; remainder is for priests	Yes	Removes the stain caused by specific sins	Shows necessity of acknowledging sin
Guilt offering	Restitution offering	5:14-6:7; 7:1-10	A ram; also repayment plus 20% to God or wronged person	Fat is burned; remainder for the priests; wronged person receives the repayment plus 20%	Yes	Repays wrong against God and person	Always pursuing reconciliation
